

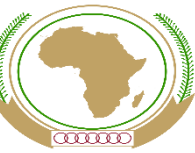

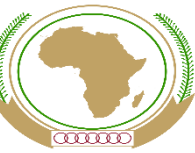

# Legislative mandate

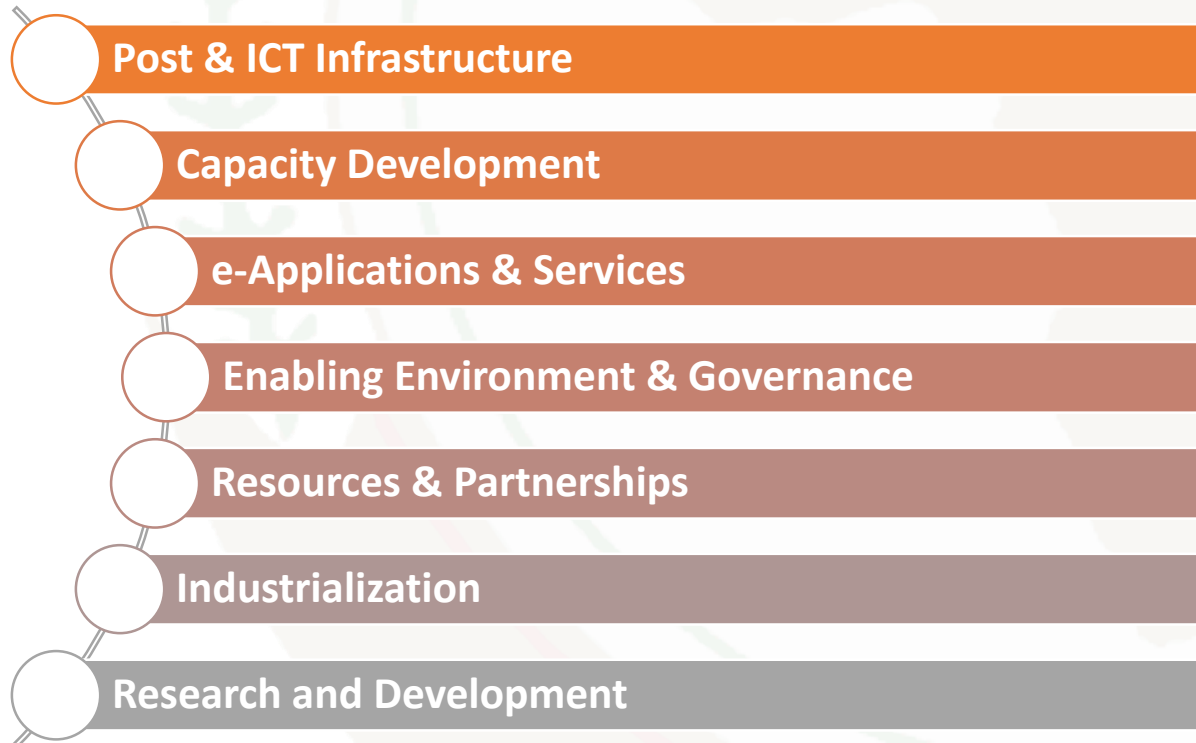


- 2012 Khartoum Declaration from Ministers in charge of ICT  
↳ Request for a coherent, unified, harmonized Information Society/Communication and Information Technologies (IS/CIT) strategy for the continent. Several workshops and meetings involving RECs, Specialized Institutions

# Key Features of CISA



- Mission/Purpose: “Coordinate, promote and facilitate the development of Posts & ICT to accelerate the integration and Socio-Economic development of the Continent”;
- Vision: “By 2024 at least half of Africa's population will have access to affordable broadband services”;
- Seven (7) Strategic Pillars:

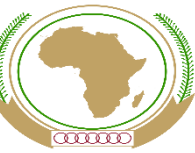


# Roadmap towards finalization of CISA



- Continue open consultations with sectoral stakeholders and define a matrix of responsibilities;
- Elaborate targets and performance measures for each strategic output in each pillar
- Identify Priority Programmes and Projects (Flagships), associated champions and lead institutions in correlation with the AU agenda 2063;
- Identify Quick wins;
- Elaborate implementation and performance management structure for delivery
- Quantify the resources requirements for implementation of the strategy;
- Develop a communications and outreach plan to promote the strategy.

- ↳ Implementation of the roadmap taking into account the available resources
- ↳ Road map will be revised according to the agreed Digital Africa initiative with EU.



- CISA is going on but at the rate of available resources
- Need to take into account CISA in the 2018-2020 priorities
